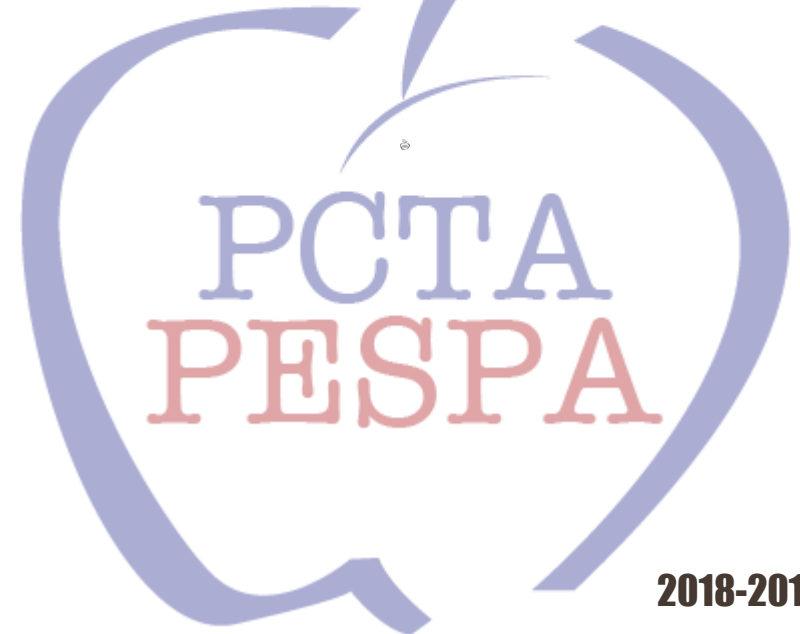

### **CRACKING THE MARZANO CODE 2.0 – MEMBERS ONLY**

Questions about the new focus model? Cracking the Marzano Code is a systems approach to a universal understanding of Marzano and your evaluation. Come learn about the evaluation system and what administrators are looking for when they walk in your classroom. This course is 2 hours long, is not eligible for component points, and is open to MEMBERS ONLY.

### **CULTURALLY RESPONSIVE PEDAGOGY**

Raise your awareness about culture in the classroom and strengths-based teaching. This research-based course delves into the beliefs of school culture and those of different ethnic groups. Learn how constraints in the learning environment unintentionally can limit learning and the role of the educator. (3 component points; PLN Course #: 26800; Aligns with the district's Equity Champion work; free for members and non-members.)

### **ESE: MANAGING ANTI-SOCIAL BEHAVIOR**

The anti-social actions of a small but powerful number of students in school not only put their own academic success at risk, but threaten the learning environment for everyone. This course presents research on emotional and behavioral issues of students who consistently act out. We will learn strategies to reduce and/or prevent the occurrence of disruptive or dangerous outbreaks. This course is 3 sessions for a total of 18 hours face to face & 2 hours of assignments. (20 ESE Component points; PLN Course #:25951) (Fee for non-members: \$150 or a signed membership form.)

### **CPR**

Upon successful completion participants will be certified. The training is certified by the American Safety and Health Institute. Participants will be required to pass a number of skills tests during the course to receive and maintain their certification. (8 component points; PLN Course #: 26945. There is a \$15 materials fee for members and a \$60 fee for non-members. The fee will be reduced to \$15 with a signed membership form.)

### **ESOL ESSENTIALS**

This face-to-face class is a research-based course from AFT that counts towards ESOL certification. It is a 4-session course for 30 face to face hours (7.5 hours each day plus a 30 min lunch). There will be homework and reading assignments. (60 ESOL component points; PLN Course #:19828. Fee for non-members: \$200 or a signed membership form. ### **ESOL APPLIED LINGUISTICS**

This face-to-face class is the same content that the district offers and counts towards ESOL certification. It is a 4-session course for 30 face to face hours (7.5 hours each day plus a 30 min lunch). There will be homework & reading assignments. (60 ESOL component points; PLN course #:19833. ### **GENERAL KNOWLEDGE PREP – MATH ONLY**

This study session includes help with preparing for the FTCE General Knowledge Math test. (This course is 3 hours long and is not eligible for component points. Free for members and non-members.)
